

## Fort Myers Beach now mandates "No New Check-In's for 90 Days"



Hello, again --

Yesterday the Fort Myers Beach Town Council met in emergency session and adopted new public health and safety measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19.

They have mandated a 90-day ban on stays at hotels, inns, timeshare resorts and all private vacation rentals.

Reservations and new check-in's from now through the end of June are currently prohibited, but the Council will regularly review this timeframe for possible modification,
