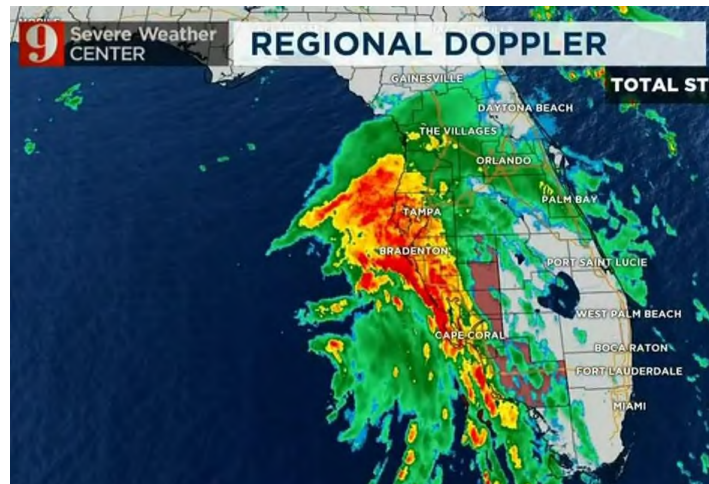

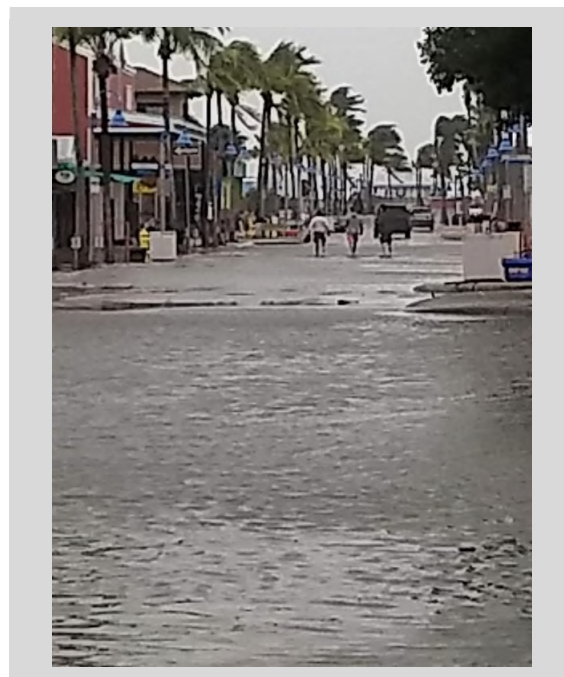
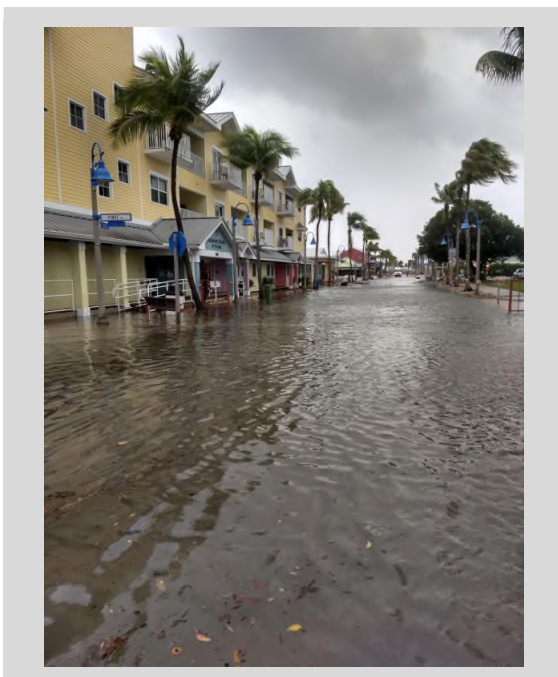
"Eta" Visits SW FL

Captain Romance made its last departure a couple of weeks ago.

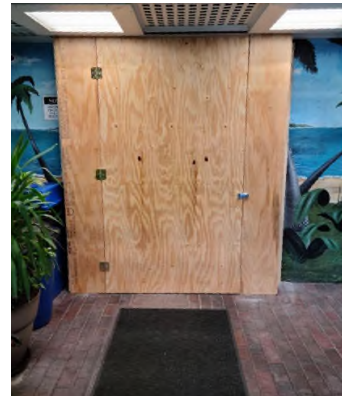
Here's a shot of the new owners driving it away to their business in Bonita Springs.
