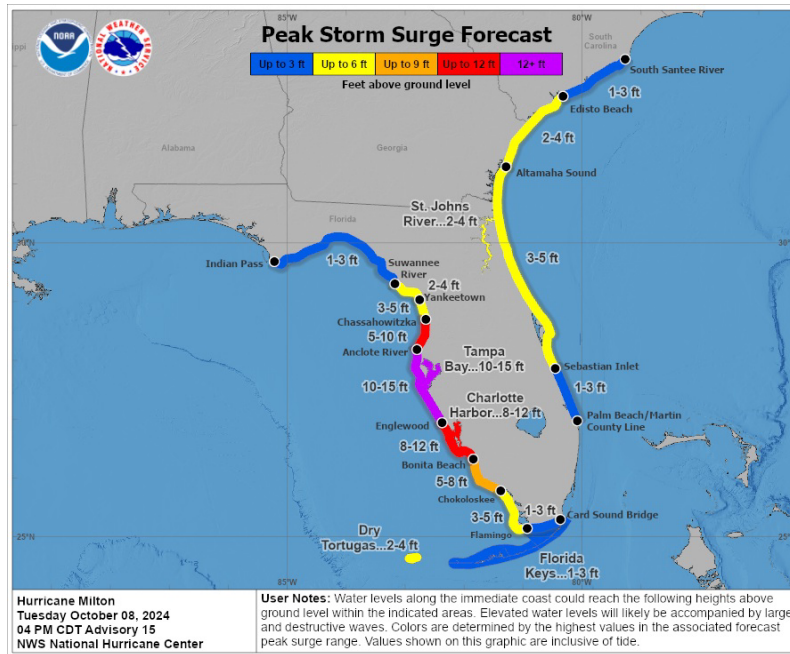

## And now... we wait for Milton

The Town of Fort Myers Beach issued a mandatory evacuation order effective yesterday afternoon.

Paul, Laurie, Jordan and I spent Sunday and Monday securing the units, the rooftop, the pool, and the elevators. We moved the entire contents of the ground floor office, maintenance room and housekeeping room safely above a storm surge. Our computer systems have been dismantled, **including the phones**, so we aren't receiving calls and voicemails at this time.

Based on the National Hurricane Center's current forecast and warnings, Marina Village will most probably be closed for a while. It will take time after Milton has passed to get access to the island, to assess the status of our property and the essential services such as power and water, and to deal with clean-up and repairs.

We have prepared for the worst. Now we must be patient .. and pray for the best.
